Terms, conditions and rules for entry:

- A minimum of **six 250ml or four 330ml bottled** samples are required for this competition (bigger bottles are accepted). **NO Kegs, you are responsible for bottling your own product. If you bottle from a keg for the National Beer Trophy, please ensure to mark bottles individually with full details of the beer.**
- The samples must be labelled and identified, if you only have a provisional label or mock-up, please use it. However, do not glue anything over your commercial label as well need to make pictures of the winning beers.

- The cost is **R600 (ex VAT) R690.00** including per entry.
- The **Beer Association of South Africa** is sponsoring the new **"Low or No"** category in this year's SANBT competition. The **"Low or No"** sub categories are for beers with an **alcohol content of less than 3.9% and includes beer that is produced as being non-alcoholic**. The beer can fit any style in accordance with **the 2015 BJCP guidelines**. **ENTRY IS FREE** for these two sub-categories for all South African commercial brewers.
- Delivery of entries will be open from the **15th September 2021 and will close on the 8th October 2021**. Beers will be judged in October and results will be announced in November (dates will be communicated as soon as they are confirmed).

Rules of eligibility

To be eligible for a medal, trophy and/or prize, beers must fulfil the following criteria:

- Must be **brewed in the Republic of South Africa**
- Your brewery is **fully licensed** for the manufacturing and commercial sale of beer in the Republic of South Africa
- Your brewery is **currently operating** with at least one beer, commercially available for sale at retail to the public (i.e., Tap room, bar, restaurant, retail store)
- Must have been released to the market for commercial purpose.
- A minimum 51% of the fermentable carbohydrates from **malted grains**.
- Beverages made with malt substitutes, honey, fruit or fruit juices or anything other than malted grains as the majority of fermentable sugars are not eligible to participate
- Each beer may be **entered only once** and may not be entered in multiple categories.
- A beer may not be renamed and entered in multiple categories.
- Contract beers: If you own the rights to a brand, but your beer is produced by another brewery, you are still eligible to enter the SANBT. **Any award won by a contract brand is property of the brand owner**, not the brewery producing the beer.
- For a **collab beer**, please disclose it so all parties can be awarded.
- To keep the level of the National Beer Trophy in line with the great quality of South African beers, **only the top tiers will be awarded with no more than 30% of the entries being medalled.**
- **REMEMBER TO ONLY USE BJCP GUIDELINES 2015, PLEASE.**
